

Wilderness Stewardship Certificate Program

Grading Policy and Terms of Registration

1. Students are expected to progress through the certificate course of study at a pace arranged with and approved by their mentor.
2. Students will have a maximum of nine months to complete an individual certificate, after which they can petition their mentor for a three-month extension. When the extension expires (12 months enrollment), the student must re-register to continue their course of study.
3. Each e-course assessment must be passed with a score of 80% or better prior to the student progressing to the next assignment and/or e-course in the certificate course of study. Assessments may be retaken an unlimited number of times.
4. Assignments (distributed learning components) that receive a grade lower than 80% may be revised and resubmitted one time. Resubmitted assignments will be eligible for a maximum grade of 80%.
5. Successful completion of a certificate program course of study is evidenced by the above criteria and an overall course of study grade of 80%.
